

FAQs

How do I register for a USSSA event?

- Refer to each individual event listing and/or contact the event director for more information. Each event director will have the option for teams to register by mail or online based on preference.
- For Nebraska USSSA State Championship events - teams have the option to register online or by mail in 2013.
- All event registrations and payments for USSSA sanctioned events must be made by the deadline and in advance of the tournament schedule. No team will be placed on the schedule without an official registration.

I lost my username and password to the www.ussa.com website for my team account? How do I retrieve that information? [Click here](#) and input your E-mail address. Your information will be sent to your E-mail account within a few minutes. If you do not receive an E-mail, please be sure to check your bulk or spam box.

Do I need a USSSA Membership and what is the cost? To participate in any USSSA sanctioned event you must have a current USSSA team membership. The annual membership year is from August 1st until July 31st of each year. The cost is \$25 per team annually.

Do we have to purchase team insurance?

No, you do not have to purchase team insurance. However it is strongly recommended.

Why should we purchase team insurance?

USSSA team insurance covers the play and practice of any amateur activity in the sport insured. General Liability coverage is provided for players, coaches, managers, sponsors, and volunteers of the team. \$2 Million liability insurance coverage and \$100,000 of medical accident insurance with a \$100 deductible. Accident Medical Coverage is secondary to any other collectible insurance; primary if no other insurance is in force. USSSA Insurance General Liability underwriters are rated "A" by Standard and Poors, "A+" Fitch, and "A" by A.M. Best. For more details and also to purchase USSSA team insurance [click here](#).

I purchased team insurance. How do I get our practice facility named as additional insured on the certificate? E-mail insurance@ussa.com with the facility details (name/address) and request to have that added to your certificate.

Do we need to submit our roster on the USSSA website?

Yes, all USSSA teams should have an active roster online. In 2013 this is a requirement for all 2013 USSSA State Championship events. In 2014 this will be a requirement for all USSSA sanctioned events. Please plan ahead.

How do I know which division to register my team?

There are three options. D1, D2 and D3. D1 teams consist of ELITE travel teams, D2 teams consist of COMPETITIVE travel teams and D3 teams consist of school based teams. D1 and D2 teams are composed of players from several school districts, school-based teams must have players from the same school district.

How many players can we have on our roster?

You can have up to 15 players on your roster.

How do we qualify for the USSSA Tournament of Champions?

In 2013, you can qualify directly into this event by finishing in the top two in any division/grade at the Nebraska USSSA State Championships.

How do I get a refund?

E-mail the tournament director and request a refund. All cancellations must be in writing.

What is the refund policy?

Requests made 10 days prior to event = full refund

Requests made 7 days or less = no refund

**All online refunds will have merchant processing costs deducted.*

My team's points are incorrect, whom do I contact?

Contact the tournament director who input your event results and request that they make the correction for you.

My team's game results are incorrect, whom do I contact?

Contact the tournament director who input your event results and request that they make the correction for you.

My team is planning on playing at a USSSA Regional National event and also possibly the Tournament of Champions. How many roster changes can we do?

1. Teams are allowed to add two players after participating in the USSSA State Championships prior to playing in a USSSA Regional National event.
 2. Teams are allowed to add 1 player after participating at a USSSA Regional National event.
- State directors will monitor rosters and freeze them in order to make sure teams comply with these rules.
